- \$60,000 in expert volunteer time given to projects..

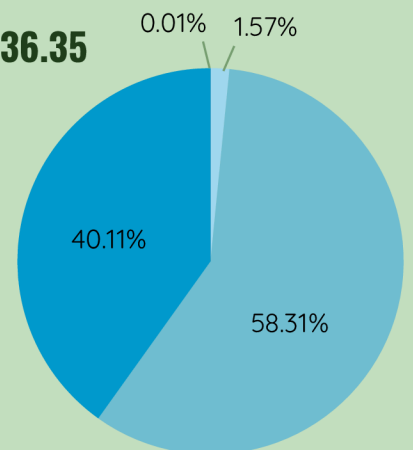
